Duration

Option 1: 8 hours classroom training and assessment

Option 2: Internet mode - 5 hours classroom training and assessment combined with 3 hours self-paced online learning (English language only)

Course Content

- + Respond to an emergency situation
- + Apply basic first aid procedures in accordance with internationally accepted first aid procedures
- + Perform CPR including basic use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- + Communicate details of the incident
- + Evaluate own performance
