

# Course Outline



This course enables participants to respond to emergency incidents and provide the skills necessary to provide emergency medical care with a limited amount of equipment and resources. This is an advanced course for first responders, providing a vital link prior to the arrival of more qualified personnel. Successful course participants can recognize the seriousness of the patient's condition or extent of injuries to assess requirements for emergency medical care and administer appropriate emergency medical care for life threatening injuries relative to airway, breathing and circulation.

This course has been designed for industry that operates in remote areas, without immediate professional ambulance services, where advanced hospital services maybe hours away.
