This course enables participants to describe the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

Duration

Option 1: 16 hours classroom training and assessment

Option 2: Internet mode - 8 hours classroom training and assessment combined with 8 hours self-paced online learning (English language only)

Course Content

- + Assess the situation
- + Apply advanced first aid procedures in accordance with internationally accepted first aid procedures
- + Respond to an unconscious casualty
- + Perform CPR including basic use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- + Communicate details of the incident
- + Evaluate own performance

- + Nil

- + Multiple choice quiz
- + Progressive practical assessment

Award Issued

- + Statement of Attainment (on successful completion)

Recertification

- + Legislative approval valid for 3 year from the completion date.
